CMOS Undergraduate Scholarships (\$500)

Deadline: March 15, 2014

Criteria: Awarded to two students in their penultimate year who will be enrolled in at least four half-courses in their final year in one or more of the following fields: meteorology, oceanography, limnology, hydrology or climatology. Must be a Canadian citizen (or have landed immigrant/permanent resident status) and have career aspirations in atmospheric sciences, oceanography, hydrology or limnology.

The Weather Network / CMOS Scholarship (\$1500)

Deadline: March 15, 2014

Criteria: Awarded to a female student in her penultimate year of an Atmospheric Science degree who is in good academic standing (GPA \geq 75%). Must be a Canadian citizen (or have landed immigrant/permanent resident status) with career aspirations in meteorology.
